

# Zoë Më

Sometimes the melancholy rests like dewdrops in the morning light, sometimes it reflects in the neon glow of the city – Zoë Më is a storyteller with two hearts beating in her chest. She sings in German and French, blending poetry pop and chanson.

Born on October 6, 2000, in Basel, she spent her childhood in Germany from 2003 to 2009 before settling in the bilingual canton of Fribourg, Switzerland. By the age of ten, she had already begun writing her own songs. Though she did not grow up in a bilingual family, she discovered her love for the language of Molière early on, learning it at school and with friends.

Today, Zoë Më builds musical bridges across linguistic and cultural boundaries. „No one switches languages within a song as seamlessly as Zoë Më“, and „The Fribourg native breaks down the musical boundaries of Switzerland“, write Swiss Radio and Television (SRF/RTS). With her bilingual EP „Dorienne Gris“, released in May 2024, the 24-year-old received the prestigious titles of „SRF3 Best Talent“ and „RTS Artiste Radar“.

She also captivates live audiences, performing at major festivals such as the Montreux Jazz Festival and Luzern Live. In 2025, she will represent Switzerland at the Eurovision Song Contest in Basel with her song „Voyage“, gaining international recognition. She uses this platform to take her audience on a journey toward more humanity.
